Survey on experiences of discrimination in the workplace



Dear Colleague,

your Betriebsrat (works council) is committed to ensuring that all employees are treated equally and fairly. We strive to always be available for all problems and to be at your side. Unfortunately, we cannot be everywhere at the same time and some problems may be better reported anonymously.

This can touch on various issues: Does a supervisor say you work too slowly because you are older? Do you not get a promotion because you sometimes miss work because of your sick child? Does someone insult you because of your country of origin? Whether this treatment comes from colleagues or superiors - we as the works council do not want to accept such behaviour.

We would therefore like to give all employees the opportunity to tell us about problems and concerns in a short survey. We want to protect you from discrimination at work and support you if you experience unfair treatment. In order to do this, we need to know what your experiences are in our company.

That's why we are launching a survey of all employees:

You can fill in the survey either online or on paper. Tell us what is going well or badly - this is your chance to have a say in good working conditions for all. Whether you are a temporary, on-call or agency worker - everyone can take part.
